

### MARTINE LABBÉ

Canadian musician, Martine Labbé is also an arranger, composer, producer, mentor and entrepreneur. She has been travelling the world for almost a decade with the Wesli band and performed in about 20 countries. With an honors degree in jazz from Concordia University, she has held a chair in more than a dozen Montreal big bands, some with whom she has recorded several albums, notably with Beth McKenna.

She released her debut album Protea independently in 2017, before pursuing her career in Morocco, where she co-founded 3ZEM, a production and management company, and shared the stage with musicians such as Jamal Nouman in a chamber orchestra, Neta Elkayam who modernizes the Moroccan-Jewish repertoire and Meryem Aassid who gives a jazz twist to traditional Amazigh music.

Performing her own music in Morocco, Canada and France in 2023, she has also shared the stage with the Grammy winner band Flor de Toloache in their latest E.U. tour.

### PROTEA/prautia/

In 2017, she released her first album in Canada as a composer, conductor and producer. Protea is a South African flower, serving a dual intention of honouring the roots of the musical genres at the heart of her practice and representing strength, diversity, courage and transformation, flagship values for a plural and harmonious society. This first opus is an exploration of her diverse influences, in a rather traditional jazz style.




